Brief history of BME



1782 – Emperor Joseph II establishes the
Institutum Geometricum

first in Europe to award engineering degrees to students of land surveying, river control, and road construction

1856 – The institute becomes Royal Joseph Polytechnique

1862 – Royal Joseph Polytechnic becomes the Royal Joseph University
among the first institutions in Europe, to train engineers on university level

1949 – Technical University of Budapest (BME)

consists of 5 faculties: Civil Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Architecture, Chemical Engineering and Electrical Engineering

1955 – Faculty of Transportation Engineering is established

1998 – Faculty of Natural Sciences and Faculty of Economic and Social Sciences
are established

2000 – Official name changes to Budapest University of Technology and
Economics (acronym remains BME)



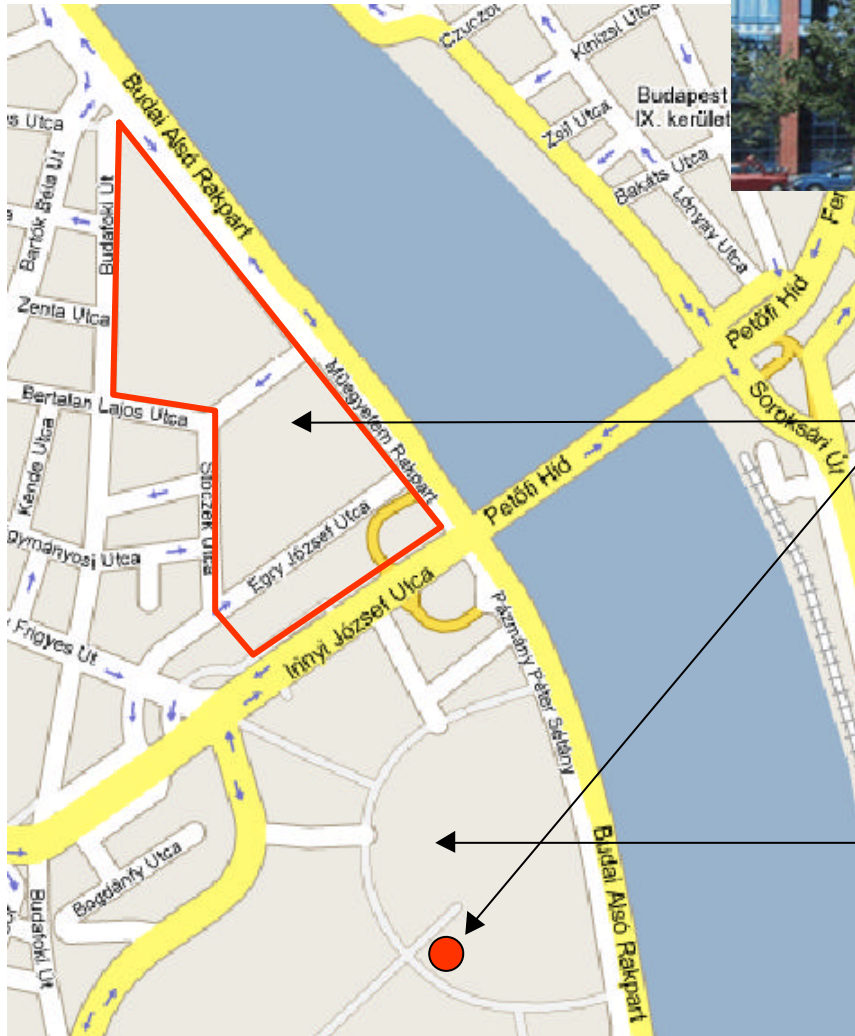
Current situation

- 8 faculties
- 110 departments and institutes
- 1100 lecturers and 400 researchers
- 14000 students (from 50 countries)

- BME issues 70% of all engineering degrees in Hungary
